EQUIPMENT SANITIZING GUIDELINES

Datascan strives to provide a solution to our clients that is timely, accurate and above all, safe to use. With this in mind, we have taken measures to ensure the product you receive has been thoroughly disinfected and is safe to use.

New Datascan Equipment Sanitizing Procedures

- All Datascan employees are required to wear masks and gloves, while operating on the warehouse floor. This measure has been taken to protect our employees from infection as well as protect our customers by way of contact with the equipment being received by the stores.
- During the receipt of equipment back to Datascan, we have implemented a procedure to scrub all inbound shipments with 91% isopropyl alcohol. This is to reduce the probability of the spread of disease via our scanners and upload devices coming in to our warehouse.
- Prior to equipment leaving the facility, during the programming and QC process, the equipment is again scrubbed with 91% isopropyl alcohol. This is also intended to further reduce the possibility of spread outside of our warehouse.
- We use alcohol for disinfecting because it is non-conductive and is unlikely to damage the electronic components of our solution.

Customer Equipment Sanitizing Suggestions

In an effort to keep everyone as safe as possible, we strongly suggest that the following steps be taken to sanitize equipment between employee shifts and also between multiple store use.

- Alcohol is the preferred method for cleaning the equipment because it can be applied liberally without damaging the equipment.
- Standard disinfectants like Lysol and Clorox wipes may be used, if necessary. **Do not apply standard disinfectants directly to the equipment.** Instead, apply the disinfectant to a cloth or paper towel prior to scrubbing the equipment.
